ALAIN TERZIAN UNVEILS THE NOMINATION OF 42nd CESAR CEREMONY

ELLE & FRANTZ at Top of the Nominees

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USPA NEWS - The first round of voting for the 2017 César was closed on 24 January 2017 at midnight. "Elle" by Paul Verhoeven and "Frantz" by François Ozon are the most famous films for the Cesars 2017. Isabelle Huppert and Marion Cotillard are nominated.

ALAIN TERZIAN PRESIDENT OF CESARS ACADEMY UNVEILS THE NOMINATIONS FOR 2017-----

Alain Terzian, President of the Academy, unveils the results of the list of the nominees to the César's edition of 2017 at the Press Conference given on Wednesday, January 25th 2017 at the Le Fouquet's restaurant, alongside Jérôme Commandeur the Master of Ceremonies. The results were dumped during the night by Voxaly, under the supervision of a bailiff. To start with, Alain Terzian, congratulates Isabelle Huppert for her nomination to the Oscars, best actress category. The French actress Isabelle Huppert, was rewarded last week in Los Angeles by the Golden Globe of the best actress for her role as a woman raped in "Elle" by Paul Verhoeven. She, then, was the invited Monday evening by the French Minister of Culture, Audrey Azoulay, on the occasion of the handing Of the "French Cinema Award" created by UniFrance in charge of promoting French cinema abroad. "Everywhere in the world, French cinema is loved for its audacity, the sense of subversion and transgression," assured the actress in her thanks. "Whatever happens in the coming months, I hope that this culture will be carried to the highest level. It is a powerful and essential political lever," added Huppert.

THE CESAR RACE IS NOW OFFICIALLY LAUNCHED UNVEILING 11 NOMINATIONS-----

The Cesar race is officially launched, and without surprises, Paul Verhoeven's Elle is one of the favorites of the competition with 11 nominations, including Best Actress for Isabelle Huppert, who is also in the running for the Oscar 2017. The film "Frantz" of François Ozon is not outdone, with Pierre Niney and Paula Beer who are both in the race for their respective roles. "Divines" is the first film of Houda Benyamina and comes out as the real surprise of the competition with 7 nominations. Rarely did a ceremony of the Cesar begin with so many scandals. A week after nominating director Roman Polanski as president of the ceremony, social networks and many feminists became inflamed. The director, accused of rape for 40 years, decided to abandon his post on 24 January. But the director of the Académie des César, Alain Terzian has not announced his replacement.

Roman Polanski who was first appointed to chair the ceremony of the Awards ceremony on February 24th, he then decided not to accept the offer. "Roman Polanski is one of the greatest artists on the planet who has decided not to follow up, the rest belongs to everyone." Yesterday was a complicated day, I respect everyone's comments, Associated with no controversy, "explained Alain Terzian. However, the director's replacement was not announced.
